

Instructions to Authors for Preparing Camera-ready Papers:

The authors are requested to read the instructions carefully and format the submissions according to the ACM guidelines. The camera-ready version of the papers are due on September 28, 2009.

- 1) Please use the ACM Word or LaTeX style templates to prepare the papers. The templates are available at <http://www.acm.org/sigs/publications/proceedings-templates> .
- 2) The page size and margin size should not be altered from the specifications used in the template. ACM Computing Classification categories and terms must be applied. The computing classification scheme is available at <http://www.acm.org/about/class/1998> .
- 3) The maximum limit of a paper is 6 pages.
- 4) ACM requires that all papers must include a copyright paragraph and a copyright strip at the bottom of the first column of the first page. The ACM Standard Copyright paragraph and strip are provided below.
